Dear local businesses & persons interested in preserving Fulton County History:

The Fulton County Historical Society each year holds the annual Trail of Courage Living History Festival (the third weekend) September 16-17. This is very educational and fun for all ages and brings thousands of people into Fulton County to help preserve and keep the history of this area alive for future generations. We are seeking sponsorships or matching funds to cover the cost of the performers. These performers receive stipends ranging from \$200 to \$1,200 accordingly for the type of program and size of groups represented.

The festival has two stages on which we have programs all day – these are hired musicians and speakers that portray the pre-1840 time period. The Indiana Arts Commission has provided funds towards hiring these programs and each year the amount varies. This year we will receive \$3,938.00 of the \$9,522.88 needed to pay for this year's programs. We also spend over \$4,000.00 each year on advertising.

The total expenses for putting on the Trail of Courage each year is approximately \$31,000. This includes all of the advertising, port-a-jons, food supplies to run three food booths (buffalo burger, chips and apple dumpling), and the program personnel. This is the museum's biggest fundraiser for the year and last year brought 13,000 people for the weekend to Fulton County. They often buy gasoline, food & other items in Fulton County.

We will have a special bulletin board at the entrance by the admissions booth listing all local sponsorships and include you in the program that is handed out at admissions gate.

We appreciate all the local support by you and others in the community for supporting all the endeavors of the Fulton County Historical Society to help preserve the history of Fulton County.

A Grant of \$5,000.00 made possible by appropriated funds from the Indiana State legislature in conjunction with funds from the National Endowment for the Arts, Indiana Arts Commission and the Community Foundation of St. Joseph County to FCHS! This is to hire special music programs for our 42nd Trail of Courage Living History Festival Sept.16-17. The IAC has been awarding grants to FCHS since 1980 to help fund the historic arts at the Trail of Courage.

This grant is more than year but cuts at the Federal level are still a threat, so your help is very important. The total cost of all paid programs this year is approximately \$9,500 so we need to raise more than just the \$5,000 to help. This grant has to be matched dollar for dollar by local contributions or we cannot claim the IAC grant! We also spend over \$4,000.00 each year on advertising.
